## **Dentist of 25 Years Reveals Innovative Numbing Technique**

**OREM, UT**—TuttleNumbNow is a one step localized interosseous anesthesia method introduced by Dr. Gregory K. Tuttle, DDS that he claims will be the primary modality due to its instant efficiency and low-cost implementation.

“The single biggest frustration for the dentist and the single biggest frustration for patients is if they can’t get numb,” says Dr. Tuttle. “I wanted to find a better way to help my patients. There are other interosseous anesthesia methods, but this method only costs pennies on the dollar. It doesn’t involve fancy, high-priced machinery, and it actually gets the patient numb.”

The TuttleNumbNow technique has caught the interest of leading researchers, manufacturers and educators of the dental world. Dr. Tuttle decided to come public in 2015 with his findings upon the graduation of his son from the College of Dental Medicine at Midwestern University in Glendale, AZ.

“When I sat at the graduation ceremony and the speaker talked about giving back to the profession, I knew it was time,” says Dr. Tuttle. “I am committed to improving dentistry for the next generation and passing on the highest standard of care.”

Dr. Tuttle decided after 12 years of perfecting the TuttleNumbNow technique, it was time to introduce fellow dentists to his effective discovery that provides the following:

- **Simple Efficiency**—Using a mosquito-like needle, this technique allows dentists to work in all four quadrants in one appointment.
- **Instant Numbness**---TuttleNumbNow works immediately, so there is no waiting for the anesthetic to work.
- **Eliminates Excess**—TuttleNumbNow enables dentists to use a simple needle and a single carpule of anesthesia.
- **Less Risk**---This technique eliminates all potential law suits, difficulties and side effects of IA nerve blocks.

“I developed a way to take care of dental problems in the entire mouth in the same visit, as pain free as possible using common products found in every dental office,” says Dr. Tuttle “It does for 19 cents what thousands of dollars tries to do.”

Dr. Tuttle plans to introduce the 20-step technique to leaders in the industry, but ultimately wants to make a difference for every dentist and patient. TuttleNumbNow is positioned to become the new injection of choice, replacing anesthesia methods.

“What I wanted to do, I discovered that I could do,” says Dr. Tuttle. “And that’s to set down the syringe, pick up the drill.”
